# Nullarbor Golf Challenge

## Play the World's longest golf course

12 - 27 October 2009



Take an amazing journey traversing two Australian States; South Australia and Western Australia, from Adelaide to Perth via the Nullarbor Plains while playing your way around the world's "longest" golf course.

The Nullarbor Links golf course is unique. The 18 hole par 72 course spans 1365 kilometers and crosses two states, with a hole in each participating town or roadhouse (plus one working sheep station) along the Eyre Highway, from Ceduna in South Australia to the famous gold mining town of Kalgoorlie, Western Australia.

Each hole will include a green and tee and a somewhat rugged outback-style natural terrain fairway! Keeping a score card will be essential! Doubt if you will need a full set of clubs, but your call. Naturally, on a par 72 course there will be a range of par 3, 4 and 5 holes.

On this tour you will have a lot of laughs, see startling wildlife, and plenty of opportunities to relax to enjoy your surroundings.

By stopping at the "hole locations" you will get to meet the locals and begin to appreciate the remoteness of this amazing journey.

Travelling in your own campervan will give you independence and a level of comfort. They are great vehicles to drive and are reasonably economical. You will have the chance to be independent and take in the sights.

Travel with a small group (max. of 12) of likeminded folk and be accompanied by the very experienced Doug Morland who has been travelling the outback for 14 years!
