You will really enjoy this tour which can only be attempted during the dry season. We travel a distance of approximately 3800 kms in superbly comfortable air conditioned 4WD vehicles. The scenery is diverse and always interesting. The theme of this tour is one of casual and relaxed enjoyment. The itinerary is relatively flexible so that we do have time to stop, explore, look and appreciate.

The outback is the "largest camping ground in the world"; we generally stay in good camping grounds with full facilities but we also take the opportunity to experience a couple of "Bush Camps" (July tour only).

All camping gear is supplied, tent accommodation (4 person tents) is based on twin share.

This is a really unique type of holiday which is designed for those who have a love for the outdoors.

You can choose the direction you want to travel in - Darwin to Cairns or Cairns to Darwin. The costs is the same but the itineraries do vary slightly.
